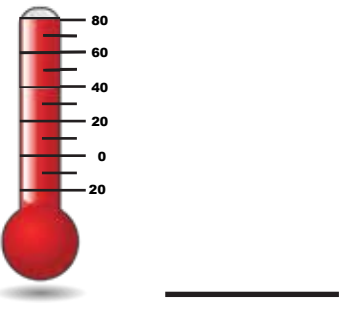
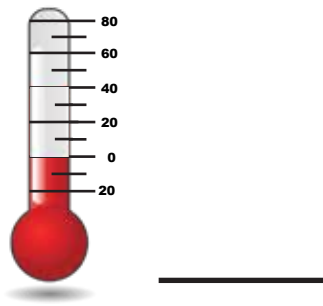
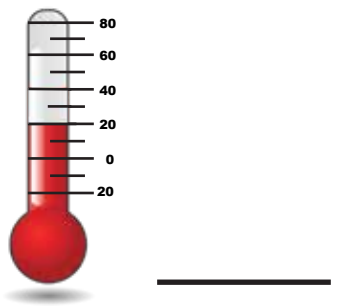
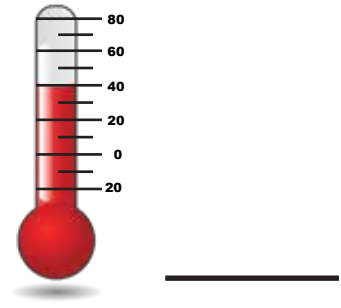
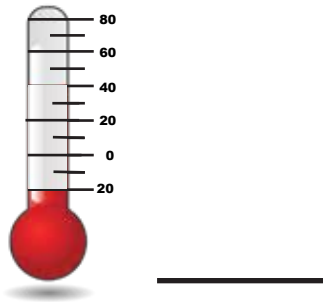
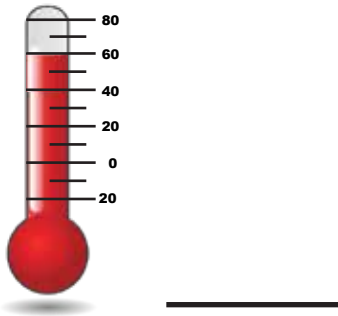


Weather and Health
